Main responsibilities...

- Solicits contributors to the news section, producing three (3) to five (5) news stories per week with the help of the news writer, contributors and freelancers.
- Writes stories about both student union and university governance, student issues, and municipal, provincial and national issues that affect the U of O community.
- Assists the managing editor, staff writers, online editor, and editor-in-chiefs with covering breaking news.
- Edits all content for the news section for structure, spelling, grammar, and style. Responsible for uploading all news content to WordPress each week.
- Oversees and edits news broadcasts in collaboration with the editors-in-chiefs.
- Ensures weekly deadlines are met.
- Coordinates visual assignments with the photographer and visuals director.
- Ensures the news section of the production document is filled out in full prior to all editorial board meetings.
